February & March Prayer Letter

Dear Faithful Supporters & Praying Partners,

Greetings, ACTS 2:28 Thou hast made known to me **the ways of life**; thou shalt make me full of joy with thy countenance. This is what I would like to share with you since my last letter. These are words that have a very powerful meaning to me and should to all that read this letter for what I am about to share with you, I pray will be a blessing to you as it was to me. It was during the month of February while visiting the young men on the 16th floor (16th is segregation). I walked up to a cell and as I spoke to one young man he began to cry immediately, so I ask him what was wrong, he told me "That I would take time out to speak with him". The young man who is 17 years old told me he was scared and could not relate to gangs. I ask him if he knew the Lord as his Savior, he said yes so after speaking with him for about an hour I had prayer and went to talk to someone else. I would like to share with you a portion of a note this young man gave me, which will bring to light the verse, Acts 2:28.

Mr. Brown,

I would like to tell you something you seem to already know is... Money means a lot to people.... Things you touch sometimes has great feeling... But nothing goes farther or deeper than to have someone that talks to you and understands **the way of life**.

This young man who is what they classify as a "safe keeper" told me he "messed up" and was sent here until his trial. He later told me that he wrote his mother a letter and told her "everything was going to be all right, he had talked to Chaplain Brown". *I wonder how that mother felt upon receiving that letter from her son.* Churches and individuals willing to give so that I could be there that day to share the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ made all this possible. **WHY?** Because you to understand "the way of life". In all the month of February the Lord blessed with **four** saved and **three** re-dedications.

The month of March was a blessing. During an Orientation, this is when new young men are made aware of the Chapel and the "religious services". During one of these services the Lord allowed me the opportunity to preach and **Four** raised their hand for salvation.

I have another young man that has been a blessing he has been saved and has also signed up for the Rock Of Ages Prison Bible Institute. He shared with me that he was mailing his certificates home to his mother to show her he has changed. This young man is 18 years old has 15 years to do in prison. He has written a poem, I would like to share with you. In all **six** young men gave their Life to Christ with several signing up for the Prison Bible Institute
