It has every thing on it and I do mean everything, from all the churches mailing addresses, to tax information. The rest of things have been going well for my family and me. My family and I want to Thank You for all those that pray for us on daily bases. This has sustained us through so many things the last two months.

The Lord blessed the Month of February with Eight precious souls saved at the prison. It was a very busy month for us and so many things have happen! I have started teaching the Character Concept class here at Western Youth. The class is going great and with a positive response from those, that is taking the class. I am Thankful for what the Lord is doing in the heart of those that come. My prayer is that some of these young men will leave this prison and become preachers, pastors, even missionaries! To God Be Glory!

I do have a Praise Report to share with you, that it might be a blessing to you as it was for my family and me. During February while traveling home from prison the oil pump on my truck went out. I know what you are thinking how this can be a Blessing! A Pastor found out that my truck was broke down. He calls me and said,

"Brother Brown, God surely is good to us, I said yes sir He surely is! Then he said Brother Brown, I met a man that said he will rebuild your engine and it will not cost you a dime" Glory!!!! I think of the little children song "My God is so BIG so strong and mighty their nothing my God can't do." I shared this with those in my class and there was a hardy "Praise the Lord".

The Month of March was a time of trails for me, as one preacher put it, "the Lord is Blessing and the devil is messing." I was sick the first two weeks of March. Nevertheless, the Lord helped me in ministering those two weeks. It was during this time I talked to several that were going through family difficulty. So many struggle with issues outside these walls. I cannot do what I do in my strength. The flesh will fail. That is why I am so grateful for praying partners who call my name out to the Lord each and everyday. I have several right here in this prison that tell me they prayed for me. What a Blessing!

In all during March, there were four precious souls saved here at Western Youth. In addition, during March, my wife went to a Women's Prison in Lexington NC. While there, she personally dealt with a women inmate. This woman told my wife she is tired of feeling empty inside. My wife said she began to share the scripture with her and had her read it back to my wife and explain to her what it meant. To make a long story short. The woman ask the Lord forgive her and save her. She told my wife no one had ever taken the time and share with her the scripture as she had. My wife told me she had spent about two hours with her. In all nine women came to know Christ as there Savior.

Looking ahead please pray for me I will be in Troy, NC. The first week in May for a Rock of Ages Prison Revival. I am looking forward to the fellowship and a great time in the Lord. The last time their ninety-seven men came out to the service. I do want to take the time and say Thank You, for your continue prayers and financial support for my family and me. May you and your family and church family have a great Easter Sunday. Let His resurrection power be new and fresh in our lives every day.
