Dear Faithful Supporters, Praying Partners,

Greetings, in the beginning of the letter let me say Thank You for your prayers these last several months. It is hard for me to express on paper since the passing of my Dad, the emotions that my family and I have had. However, life must continue. As our youngest son (Ethan) sang a song the night his Pa passed away the title of the song is "Farther Along". In one part of this song has the words "live in the sunshine" that is what my family and I have been trying to do with each passing day.

The prison work is continuing to grow. I have been teaching Character Concepts three days a week. This is a fifteen-lesson workbook provided by the ministry. I have seventeen inmates coming on Tuesday and Thursday and twelve on Friday. Please pray for the LORD to touch hearts as I try to teach these lessons. I also have a Bible study every Thursday. On January 13th, there were 70 inmates attending the Bible study, when I gave an invitation there was 17 profession's of faith in Christ that day. What joy to continue "living in the sunshine!"

Several weeks ago a officer at the prison came to me and told me something, he stated, "That he knew that I did not need a pat on the back for what I was doing." However, he felt I would want to know what a inmate had told him. The inmate said, "That eight months ago he came to prison, without God in his life." He said, "I didn't care about myself or anyone, but I met Chaplain Brown who told me about Christ." "I now have Christ in my life and a desire to do differently." The LORD can "lift you up above the shadows." If that is not enough to continue "living in the sunshine" 19 professions in faith in Christ in the month of February.

Amid all the sunshine is also a storm. My wife and I have some health problems. My wife had been working a part-time job to supplement the income needed for this family. However, due to health problems with her back she has had to quit her part-time job. Our monthly support is currently 65%, so her income will be missed. Please pray for my wife and our financial situation. I have faith and confidence in the LORD and His people that our needs will be met.

In closing we are grateful for each and everyone for your faithfulness in supporting this ministry and my family. "When we see Jesus coming in glory..... We will understand it all by and by." Thanks for Caring! Thanks for Praying!
