The Lord has helped in getting \$175.00 mth in new support back since January 04. I want to say Thank You for each and every new supporting church. Then the Lord blessed with churches increasing our monthly support. Please join with us in praying for the Lord to help in getting the financially support for my family and ministry.

I want to respond to those that have asked about our children. Our oldest son Adam fell and fractured his right ankle. He had been in a cast for four weeks and in a brace for three weeks. The Doctor told him just the other day he can now go without the brace. Carrisa our oldest is working now, pray as she seeks the Lord in direction for her life. Sarah, she is now twelve. Just the other day she was telling a neighbor about Jesus, and took her own money and bought a Spanish Bible to give to the Mother. Ethan, is nine now. He came up to me and said Daddy I think the Lord want's me to preach. If you don't mind I think I will **SHOUT** right here !!!!!!!

January was a good month of ministry at the prison. I have started teaching a Bible Study on Thursday. I felt lead of the Lord after praying to start teaching I John. The Bible study is for the New Converts to teach them two things "Joy & Assurance." I currently have about 15-20 attending. In Character Concept class that I teach on Fridays I now have 21 enrolled in this fifteen-week study.

I also have some more good news; it is with joy I can say that the Lord blessed with **Nine** souls saved at prison!! What a privilege to tell others about Him and to see Him speak to hearts and save their soul and change their life. *"O WHAT A DIFFERENCE IN MY (AND YOURS) LIFE SINCE JESUS PASSED BY !!!"*

This brings me to February. Three Years ago this month I stepped out by faith trusting the Lord to supply the needs for my family. My how quickly time has gone. I can remember my wife and I praying and surrendering to trust the Lord to speak to hearts and met the needs of our family and the ministry. I could take two pages or more just to give God the Glory for what **He** has done.

Nevertheless, I would like to share with you the most recent thing that The Lord has done for my family and ministry. My wife called me at prison and was crying and said "someone has sent us a cashier check for \$500.00 dollars, they did not even put a name on the card that came with it." All that was written on the card was " May the Lord Bless You and Your Family" .*Ain't God Good !!!!!*

This is one of many ways the Lord has blessed in helping me go to the prison. My family and I are thankful for each and every church and individuals these last three years with your vote of confidence by supporting this ministry so I can be at Western Youth.

In closing this has been probably the most difficult month in talking with young men faced with consequences of sin, new admissions, with a lot of time. Several have set in my office and have broken down and wept over what has happen in their life. The reality of sin and what it can cost!

Please let me express once again how grateful I am for each and every one of you that pray for us! Thanks for Caring!
