To make a long story short, I drove to his home and he handed me an envelope; needless to say it had more than a hundred dollars in it. The Lord surely knew our family needed the money. My family is truly thankful in how the Lord met the need. This is one of many ways the Lord has spoken to hearts and helped our family and ministry since surrendering to His work. I shared this with you that it might be a blessing and might even help someone else wondering if God can! The Lord blessed with **six** precious souls saved here at Western Youth. One of those six was on my Birthday June 16<sup>th</sup>.

July was a very busy month. The first week of July our family attended the Rock Of Ages National Conference in Murfreesboro TN. It was a tremendous blessing! I would like to tell you how the Lord met the need in going. I had a pastor call and tell me he felt lead of the Lord to take up for our ministry during Vacation Bible School. They both were doing fine then our son had some problems with the left lower jaw. The doctor had to go back and remove a small piece of bone from his gum. His is doing fine now.
