Many times I wonder as I write my prayer letters is it touching hearts, or if people even reading them! The Lord has a way of letting you know. Several weeks ago, a man told me that when I told the story about my grandmother in my last prayer letter. He used it to teach his soul winning class. Then someone in the class put out fifteen gospel tracts that day after hearing the story. Praise the Lord!

The last several months have been a time of blessing with burdens. The Blessing, as you recall in my last letter I ask you to pray about the expense of the trip to Sao Paulo Brazil, Jan 23,06 –Feb03, 06. An individual told his pastor that he wanted to give me a thousand dollars toward the trip. This person did not want me to know who they were. Just give the Lord GLORY! I purchased the plane ticket. Praise the Lord!

Then at prison nineteen first time professions of faith in Christ. To God be the Glory! The battle and burden followed afterward. Have you ever had this to happen? It seems that most of the time the battle, burden, blessing is the way it works. Nevertheless, this is what happened. I know to some of you reading this letter is already aware of what has transpired. Please be patient with me so that I might explain. Our oldest daughter Carissa was expecting her first child. Gail and I grandparents!

Carissa had complication with the pregnancy and was not able to carry the baby. At twenty-four weeks Michael Tyler Bowman was born on November 13, 2005 and lived for about ten minutes. This is something that has been very hard for my family and me. The funeral was November 16, 2005. Please continue to pray for my family and our daughter Carissa and son-in-law Daniel. Our son-in-law Daniel is in the Army at Fort Campbell KY. He will be deployed to Iraq for one year sometime after December15, 05. I ask that you put them on your prayer list. All this happened between the months of October and November.

In November a Pastor came and preached a message. The title of the message was "The Other Man." What a Blessing! Nine first time professions of faith in Christ in this service alone. One of the inmates told me, he had been reading material about "The nation of Islam." But, not anymore since, he met the other "Man." **Twelve** professions of faith in Christ end the month.

I want to Thank You for your prayers for my family! May you and your family have a Merry Christmas as we remember the birth of Christ. Jesus is the reason!
