The month of September had been a very stressful month for ministry at the prison. I had several death notices that can and do come to those in prison. The prison that I labor at houses over 700 inmates at any given time, so I am not surprised that they are not more frequent. The simple fact is that I too was dealing with the loss of my Dad whom passed away two years ago September 27,04.

Nevertheless the Lord has a way of encouraging your heart in the mist of difficulty. I have been here for nearly five years. In those five years I will get and occasional phone call from a former inmate or a phone call from a mom thanking me for helping her son.

The other day I received something for the first time a "Thank You" Card from a Mom. Inside was these words " I want to thank you for your kindness to my son. He speaks so highly of you. Your wisdom has greatly influenced him and your concern is not only a comfort to him, but also our family".

I have shared this with you that it might be an encouragement to you as well knowing that "your labour is not in vain in the Lord " I Corinthians 15:58. We serve a Risen Saviour!

The card the phone calls all came because Churches and Individuals willing to give prayerfully and financially so that together we can make a difference. THANK YOU!

October has arrived, how quickly another year has almost gone! To think I am going to Brazil again. Thanks for allowing me this opportunity to be your missionary, representing the Lord and you! What A Blessing!!!

While at my prison another great opportunity came available to me. I was able to schedule an orientation service in the chapel. There were over 45 new residents present with thirteen professions of faith in the Lord. I hope and pray that something has been said that you to found strength and encouragement. Thanks for Caring!
